- Introducing paint finishing skills

During this course you will:

- Gain an understanding of the role of different trades in the construction industry
- Develop basic skills in brickwork, site carpentry, painting and decorating, plastering and plumbing
- Learn about different tools used for different tasks
- Develop your knowledge of health and safety and safe working practices

How will I be assessed?

This is an assignment-based course and there are no exams.

You will be continually assessed by tutors throughout the course to ensure you are understanding what you are learning and whether you need any additional help in a particular area.
